## **HUSBAND AND WIFE START PRACTICING AT FAMILY MEDICINE OFFICE IN OAKWOOD**

OAKWOOD, Ga. – When Sergio Angel, MD, and Allie Angel, MD, met in medical school, they knew they’d be together for the long haul – wherever that journey took them. Turns out, that journey took them to the same family medicine practice at Northeast Georgia Physicians Group (NGPG) Oakwood, and they couldn’t be happier.

As they were searching for places to complete their residencies, they attended a conference to learn about family medicine residency programs. That’s where something caught Dr. Allie Angel’s eye.

“I was looking around and saw the laurel leaf logo,” Dr. Allie Angel said. “I remembered that logo from when I was 15 and volunteering at the hospital.”

They both learned more about the residency program and ended up interviewing in person with the Graduate Medical Education program at Northeast Georgia Medical Center. The program was a top choice of theirs, and they both were accepted.

“I think we both just enjoyed serving the diverse and close-knit community here in north Georgia during our residency,” Dr. Sergio Angel said. “So, we thought if we enjoyed that so much, why leave? If there was a way to continue serving this community, we wanted to do it.”
