Sherry Terrell: Sherry Terrell has served on the Morgan County Hospital Authority since 2011, contributing to key committees—including the Finance Committee—to help guide strategic decisions that impact patient care and organizational performance. A seasoned real estate professional with RE/MAX Around Atlanta Realty and Vice Chair of the City of Madison Planning & Zoning Commission, Sherry is also a dedicated civic leader who founded the Madison-Morgan Community Food Pantry, earning the Georgia Association of REALTORS® 2022 Good Neighbor Award for her community impact.

Huey Atkins: A member of the Morgan County Hospital Authority since 2017, Huey Atkins brings nearly five decades of emergency medical services experience to his role, having served as an EMT, paramedic, EMS director, shift captain, commander, field

Throughout his career, Huey was actively involved in advancing EMS at local, regional, and state levels—earning the Northeast Georgia EMS Council’s EMS Special Achievement Award—and remains deeply committed to civic service in Morgan County, including two terms as president of the Morgan County Rotary Club.
