AdventHealth is making it easy to get screened for breast cancer with convenient 30-minute 3D screening mammograms for \$30 in May for patients without insurance who qualify. 30 minutes could truly save your life.

Annual mammograms are still the top-recommended screening for women because it allows the earliest possible detection of issues before you experience symptoms. Breast cancer is the secondleading cause of cancer death in women in the U.S. and having your annual mammogram could be lifesaving.

Catching breast cancer early means:

- Therapies like breast conservation therapy will be most effective
- Treatment can begin early, possibly before cancer spreads to other parts of your body
- You'll have the best possible chance of recovery

It is recommended that women begin getting mammograms at age 40 unless there is a family history of breast cancer. If you're between the ages of 20 and 40, you should have a clinical breast exam by your doctor every three years.

\$30 mammograms can only be scheduled for the month of May for patients aged 40 and above without insurance coverage who qualify for a screening mammogram. Screening appointment times may vary. To receive this promotion, your mammogram must be scheduled at least a year and a day after your last mammogram.
