- <u>Timing</u>: Current CEO, CFO, Board Members, and Hospital Authority Members must be trained on all standards by December 31, 2020
- Onboarding:
  - o New Board Members must complete "Standard 1" prior to installation
  - New CEOs and CFOs must complete "Standard 1" within 60 days of their start date
  - New Board Members and CEOs, CFOs have 12 months to complete the full education program
- <u>Hospital Reporting:</u> Hospitals must make quarterly attestations of compliance activities to the Georgia Rural Health Innovation Center at Mercer University
