With an onsite Registered Dietitian Nutritionist (RDN), access through TeleMed for psychological services, and a fitness center on campus, patients are given all the resources and support for a successful weight loss journey and improvement in overall health and wellbeing.

Following lengthy planning and collaboration with Emory Healthcare the Bariatric & Metabolic Center officially opened in October of 2020. As an Emory Healthcare Affiliate, CRMC is able to provide our bariatric patients with access to psychological services through Telemed and collaborate with Emory Bariatric physicians on complex cases.
