Dublin VA Medical Center to Hold COVID-19 Town Hall

[Carl Vinson VA Medical Center](#) Director David L. Whitmer, FACHE, will hold a virtual town hall meeting via [Facebook Live](#) for Veterans, their families, and other stakeholders April 15 at 6 p.m. Whitmer will discuss Dublin VAMC COVID-19 vaccine clinics, pausing the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, and what it will take to return to normal operations.

“This virtual town hall is especially important as we’ll discuss our progress in our COVID vaccine clinics and our plan to continue vaccinating Veterans, spouses, and caregivers via the SAVE LIVES Act,” Whitmer said. “As we navigate our journey to be a High Reliable Organization, it’s important to be transparent about pausing the J&J vaccine out of an abundance of caution following CDC and FDA recommendations.”

Whitmer’s Facebook Live town hall will hold a question and answer session after the presentation and other questions after the town hall asked in the comments section of Facebook will be addressed within 24 hours. Also, Whitmer’s slides will be made available in a separate post after the virtual town hall so anyone can access the content shared via the town hall.
