Mobile Vaccine Unit Takes Vaccines to Patients

MACON, Ga., April 27, 2021 – In partnership with the Macon-Bibb County Economic Opportunity Council, Atrium Health Navicent is providing COVID-19 vaccines to participants in the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program.

Nurses from the Atrium Health Navicent mobile vaccine team will provide vaccinations at distribution events at Saint Paul AME Church, 2501 Shurling Drive, on April 27, April 29, and May 4 beginning at 8 a.m.
