Dublin VA announces Reesman to serve as interim director

Dublin, Ga.— Scott Reesman will serve as the Dublin VA Medical Center's interim director while the VA searches for a permanent medical center director.

David Scott Reesman is currently the Associate Director at the Carl Vinson VA in Dublin, Georgia. He serves as the deputy to the Medical Center Director overseeing a staff of 2,400 employees and seven Community Based Outreach Centers (CBOCs) covering most of south east Georgia.

From 2016 to 2021, Reesman served as Chief Supply Chain Officer of the VA Memphis Medical Care Healthcare with responsibility for overseeing the logistical support of the Medical Center and three Community Based Outpatient Clinics.

Reesman has been employed by the Veterans Health Administration since 2014 and is a retired U.S. Army lieutenant colonel of the Cavalry with numerous combat deployments. He is a graduate of the Command and General Staff College, and his last Command was of the 128th Brigade Support Battalion.
