BRUNSWICK, Georgia: January 17, 2024 – Members of Asbury Church in Baxley, Georgia, recently donated 50 new blankets, along with dozens of hat and glove sets and socks, to the Southeast Georgia Health System Nunnally House as part of their Christmas outreach ministry.



Asbury Church member Debra Youmans learned of the Nunnally House through Glenn and Sherry Beach. The couple had stayed at the Nunnally House during Glenn's cancer treatments in 2015. According to Youmans, "Sherry and Glenn shared with me how much Nunnally House meant to them, so I asked if they knew of any needs we might be able to fill for our outreach ministry."

The Nunnally House is a 40-room residential facility located adjacent to the Brunswick Campus. It offers cancer patients and family members of critically ill patients home-like lodging for the duration of their treatment or their loved ones admittance. There are also rooms for on-call staff members and medical students with the Medical College of Georgia.
