## Southeast Georgia Health System and College of Coastal Georgia Host Nursing and Healthcare Professions Camp

BRUNSWICK, Georgia: March 22, 2024 – Southeast Georgia Health System and College of Coastal Georgia are excited to host a Nursing and Healthcare Professions Camp this summer for high school students entering grades 11 and 12.



During the unique four-day camp, students will shadow clinical staff and other health care professionals in both simulation and real-life settings. In addition, students will earn a CPR and basic first aid certificate, issued by Coastal Georgia nursing faculty.

"The camp is an excellent opportunity for high school students to gain an understanding of the diverse possibilities a career in health care offers," says Shannon Wainright, RN, MBA, director, Patient Care Services. "In addition, the camp increases awareness of the exceptional education opportunities offered by Coastal Georgia and the quality of health care we provide at our Health System."

Students will have two opportunities to participate in the four-day camp--June 4-7 or July 16-19. Space is limited and participants must be in good academic standing. To register, students must submit an application, letter of recommendation from a school official, and a Nursing and Healthcare Professions Camp essay by Monday, April 15 (for the June camp) or Monday, May 13 (for the July camp). Registration information can be found at sghs.org/nursecamp. The cost of the four-day camp is \$165 upon acceptance. An additional option that includes camp fees, all meals and overnight campus residential housing at Coastal Georgia is available for \$355.
