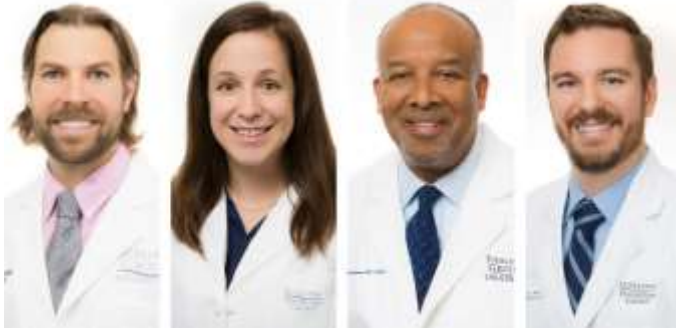




Colquitt Regional Medical Center Announces New Medical Executive Committee Leadership
