



Colquitt Regional Health System Holds Ribbon Cutting for New Emergency Medical Services Location

MOULTRIE, GA — Colquitt Regional Health System recently held a ribbon-cutting ceremony and open house to celebrate the opening of Colquitt County’s new Emergency Medical Services (EMS) facility, located at 314 Veterans Parkway North in Moultrie.

The new EMS station represents a major investment in strengthening emergency response capabilities and enhancing patient care throughout the region. The modern facility features expanded ambulance bays, improved training and meeting spaces, upgraded technology, and comfortable accommodations for EMS personnel on shift.

“This new EMS facility is a tremendous step forward for our community,” said Colquitt Regional President and CEO Jim Matney. “Our EMS professionals are often the first point of contact for patients in critical need, and providing them with the tools, space, and support they deserve ensures that we continue to deliver exceptional, lifesaving care when it matters most.”
