Dublin VA Medical Center to Host Annual Patriot Day Ceremony Sept. 11

DUBLIN, Ga. — The Carl Vinson VA Medical Center will host its annual Patriot Day and Day of Service and Remembrance on Friday, Sept. 11, at 8:30 a.m., honoring the memory of those lost in the terrorist attacks of Sept. 11, 2001, and celebrating the enduring spirit of America. The ceremony will be held on the front lawn of the medical center, beside the U.S. flag.

The event will feature a formal flag raising by the Carl Vinson VA Police Department, accompanied by music, a moment of silence, and a recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

Communications Director Dr. Frank Jordan said the ceremony is open to all and extended an invitation to patriotic Americans.

“It’s important to us that we bring our community together to see how we care for America’s heroes, and so we can all connect and get to know each other. It takes a nation to honor and care for our veterans,” Jordan said.
