Shaw joins Hamilton Physician Group – Neurology

"After seven years as an engineer, I went back to school and completed medical school at Indiana University," Shaw said. "I moved into neurology because I felt that, of all of the fields of medicine, it was the one that most encompassed what makes us human — the brain, consciousness and our memories."

Shaw earned his medical degree at Indiana University School of Medicine in Indianapolis, Ind. He also completed a Neurology residency at Indiana University School of Medicine, where he was co-chief resident. He is a member of the American Academy of Neurology and the American Medical Association.

Shaw said his interest in neurology combines intellectual challenge with human interactions that draw out empathy and have real impact. Listening, not assuming he has all the answers, and treating people with respect are all practices that guide his approach to care.

"I enjoy the human interaction and being of benefit to the patients," he said. "When they tell me that I've made some difference, or even some have said that I've changed their life, I'm humbled by that. One of the reasons I love neurology is that it's such a wide and varied field."

Shaw sees patients for a range of conditions, including headaches, migraines, peripheral neuropathy, dementia, multiple sclerosis, myasthenia gravis, muscle problems, nerve problems, seizures and more.
