## **Phoebe Sumter to Hold Community Listening Session**

**Albany, Ga.** – Phoebe Sumter Medical Center leaders want to hear from you. They’re planning a community listening session to share hospital updates with the community and to field questions and comments from patients and their families about the care and service they have received at Phoebe Sumter.

The listening session will focus on the emergency center, but any questions about Phoebe Sumter will be welcomed.
